

TOUR PACKAGE FOR INCREDIBLE WESTERN ODISHA

About Bolangir/Sonepur.....

The name Bolangir is said to have been derived from Balaramgarh, a fort built in the 16th Century by Balaram Deo, the 19th Raja of Balangir and founder of Sambalpur Kingdom. The district was formed on 01st November 1949 and has flanked in the northwest of Odisha by the Gandhamardan hill. The existence of Subarnapur indicates on the Cultural map of Odisha from prehistoric period. At present the district is known as Sonepur and famous for its rich cultural heritage and known as another “temple city” of the State next to Bhubaneswar.

Ex – Bolangir:

(Bolangir – Harishankar – Kantabanji – Ranipur Jharial – Bhimdungri – Balangir)

(2 Night 2 days)

Itinerary

Day – 1: Arrival Bolangir. Transfer to S.I.H.M. (Bolangir) for fresh up. Proceed to Harishankar (Rare Harihar hill shrine/2 km. trek in natural surroundings at Gandhamardan hills). Lunch at Kantabanji. Proceed to Ranipur Jharial (Soma Tirtha famous for 64 Yogini and Indralath Temples) and Bhimdunguri. Back to Bolangir & Night halt.

Day – 2: Morning departure Bolangir for Subarnameru & Sonepur, have a boat ride to Lankeshwari. Lunch at Sonepur. Proceed to Patali Srikhetra (Hideout of presiding deities of Sri Jagannath Temple complex during orthodox invasions) and Huma (Leaning Temple). Back to Bolangir. **(Tour ends)**

Package Cost: Rs.4, 800/- per head (Group size – 2 pax)

Rs.3, 050/- per head (Group size – 4 pax)

Package Includes: Ac Accommodation on twin sharing, Food (Breakfast with One principal meal) and Ac Transport.

Does not include: Boat Charge, Entry fees etc.
